

Conclusions

- Seen from the VO teams point of view, a very interesting meeting
- A new step in the building up of community interest in the VO, in a 'new' domain
- Meeting follow-up : Pragmatic attitude – create examples (national projects) and learn from them

Immediate actions (1)

- Very good input in terms of requirements on the VO
- Input on SNAP
- Not only on SNAP: a major strands of work before the Trieste IVOA meeting (May) is to summarize the requirements and compare them with existing standards (not only Data Model)
- During May Interoperability meeting: discussion on Theory-driven requirements including the relevant Working Groups

Immediate actions (2)

- Also major input for the document describing the inclusion of Theory data and services in the VO framework
- EuroVO-DCA Deliverable due November 2008
- Draft needed soon to keep the momentum created by the meeting
- Draft will be widely distributed and we hope that the meeting participants will have a look and send their comments



Information collection

- Use the DCA census to build a list of resources, including theory resources, with a few explanations and links
- Links from IVOA pages & Euro-VO pages

Other actions

- Revival of old actions which are now urgent
